



## BASIC FORENSIC INTERVIEW TRAINING

**OBJECTIVE:** This course is designed to improve techniques for investigative interviews of children in a way that obtains the most amount of factual information and reduces additional trauma to the child victim.

**Please note:** This course is no longer the prerequisite to the Advanced Forensic Interview Training (this course is now built into the advanced training). Therefore, this course is a stand-alone training for those who are only interested in attending a basic 8-hour forensic interviewing course.

**WHO SHOULD ATTEND:** This training is **exclusively** for **lead investigators** of child maltreatment crimes, including detectives, Tribal CPS, DCS investigators, designated Forensic Interviewers, and Prosecutors. *Anyone else who signs up for this course will be notified that they are being removed from the roster.*
